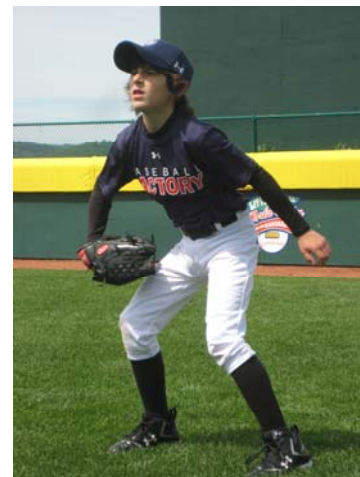

Little League® Big Diamond Prep Camp
