STAFF

Patrick Anderson: Patrick is currently a manager in the Washington Nationals Organization. He played his college ball at Mars Hill College and then went on to play professionally in the Frontier League. He served for 8 seasons with the Kansas City Royals Organization as a hitting coach. Patrick also served as a Head Coach at Hofstra University before taking the job with the Nationals. His days with Baseball Factory go back to the beginning when the company first was founded.

Dave Burba: David is a former Major League Baseball pitcher who played for the Seattle Mariners, San Francisco Giants, Cincinnati Reds, Cleveland Indians, Texas Rangers, and Milwaukee Brewers from 1990 to 2004. In his 15-year major league career, Burba's record was 115–87, with 1,398 strikeouts, and a 4.49 ERA. Burba became pitching coach of the Tri-City Dust Devils for the 2011 season, the class-A team of the Colorado Rockies. Burba served as the Pitching Coach in Double-A (Hartford Yard Goats) for the Rockies, in 2016.

Dean Espy: Dean played his college baseball at South Mountain Community College and UCLA. While at SMCC, he carried a .331 batting average with 12 home runs. At UCLA he was primarily the team's 1B and designated hitter. He was drafted in the 15th round in the 2011 MLB Amateur Draft by the Kansas City Royals. He then went on to spend a couple of years in the Rockies organization. Dean has been working with Baseball Factory since 2011.

Nolan Fuller: Nolan is the Senior Director of Baseball Player Development Events with Baseball Factory and a graduate of the University of South Carolina Beaufort, where he played and coached under the tutelage of current Pittsburgh Pirates Third Base Coach, Rick Sofield. In 2012, Fuller helped the Sand Sharks make their first NAIA World Series appearance - where they finished ranked 7th in the Nation. In his four years at USCB, the Sand Sharks compiled a record of 142-75. Nolan is also a Baseball Factory Alum, competing in events during High School.

Lew Graham: Lew played college baseball at San Diego State University, where he also got the chance to play in the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League. After college, he went on to play in the New York Mets organization. Since his playing days, Lew has served as a scout for 5 different organizations. In addition to scouting, he also coached high school baseball for several years, and coached in the San Diego Collegiate Baseball League.

Don Jamerson: Don played his college ball at Cal State University Hayward. He was then drafted by the San Francisco Giants where he reached as far as AA. He then went on to coach at St. Mary's for 5 years and won coach of the year in the W.C.C. Don also managed an 18U team that won 2 national championships. Don has been with the Factory since 2008. He assists at many PREP, player development, and showcase events. He is the Northwest Regional Director for the Factory.

Bobby Magallanes: Bobby is a former Team USA player that was drafted by the Seattle Mariners, and went on to play professionally with the Mariners, Cubs, and Astros. After playing, he started coaching with the LA Angels. He Managed at several levels of minor league ball, most being at the AA level with the Angels and White Sox. Prior to coaching he also scouted with the Angels, and has served as a Rover/Latin Liaison. Bobby is currently a hitting coach in the Cleveland Indians organization.

Craig Minetto: Craig is a former Major League Pitcher with the Oakland Athletics where he played for legendary Manager Billy Martin. He spent several seasons in the big leagues. He played college ball at Delta College in Stockton, CA. He was drafted several times but didn't earn his Big League opportunity until he pitched professionally in Italy first. He is currently a scout with San Francisco Giants.

Dan Mooney: Dan serves as a Senior Director of the Exclusive Program. Dan began his collegiate career as a catcher at Brevard Junior College. He later transferred to North Carolina State University where he was a two-time All-Atlantic Coast Conference performer. After college, Dan played professionally in the Boston Red Sox organization where he reached the double-A level before being forced to retire after an injury.
